English

Our main focus will be on animals this term.

We will begin by looking at *The Crow's Tale* which is a Native American legend about a journey to the sun. We will re-tell the story in our own words and write a character description for the crow.

After this we will learn how to write our own non-fiction reports on big cats such as leopards, lions, tigers or cheetahs. We will research facts and think about how best to present them.

Geography

This term we will learn about Kenya as well as many other countries around the world.

We will be able to locate Kenya on a map, name some of its key features and think about what it would be like to live there or visit.

We will then learn about life on the Isle of Coll in Scotland and compare these contrasting locations with our lives in England.

Music

Computing

We are astronauts
We will learn about algorithms and how to implement them as a program. We will give precise instructions and 'debug' to fix any problems.

Maths

Following the AET Maths Curriculum the children will learn about:

- Understanding halves, quarters and thirds.
- Finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, of shapes, numbers and lengths.
- Recalling and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers
- Calculating mathematical statements for multiplication and division within the multiplication tables and write them using the multiplication (\times), division (\div) and equals ($=$) signs

Art

Science
