

Health Year 4 Spring Term 2



Thematic Areas of Learning

As **Scientists**, we will be learning about how sound is made and heard. We will be exploring how volume and pitch can change for different objects.

Curiosity

As **Geographers**, we will be learning about where our food comes from and evaluating the effects of eating locally produced foods or foods produced from other countries. We will explore Fairtrade and what this means for third world countries.

English

Persuasive texts – we will be continuing our learning of how language can be used to persuade the reader to visit a local farm shop.

Discussion texts – We will be learning the features and purpose of a balanced argument to write our own texts to discuss the impacts of Fair Trade.

Communities

Food poems – We will be writing our own food poems to link with our topic. We will learn how poets use different rhyme schemes to structure their poems.

Maths

Problem solving – We will be learning how to apply our knowledge of calculations we have learnt, such as fractions, multiplication, properties of shape and measurement to problem solve.

Visualising shape – We will be learning about symmetry and symmetrical patterns. In addition, we will be identifying horizontal, vertical, perpendicular and parallel lines.

Religious Education

Our religion of focus this term will be Christianity. We will learn about About Jesus' life, death and resurrection, the parable of the unforgiving servant, Maundy Thursday and the Christian belief of forgiveness.

Communities

Computing

Children will learn about the web and how to edit HTML in web pages. They will learn how to use HTML tags, remix HTML code and make their own web page.

Music

We will be exploring musical notation and playing songs using glockenspiel.

In athletics we will develop our skills of running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination. Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance to achieve our personal best.
