


Pirates Year 1 Summer Term 1



Thematic Areas of Learning

As **Geographers**, we will explore the wider world using atlases to help us to locate and name the world's five oceans and seven continents of the world. We will compare the shapes and sizes of these and share our knowledge of some hot and cold countries across the world.

As **Historians**, we will learn about the history of pirates including the features of pirate ships, use of treasure maps and the directions on a compass. We will explore the lives of some famous pirates and will sort some pirate facts by identifying those that are myths and those that are real.

As **Musicians**, we will explore different rhythm and melodies using percussion instruments. We will also learn and perform some different sea shanties.

English

Pirate report

The children will explore the world of pirates and write their very own pirate report. The children will plunge into the life of a pirate and discover how pirates lived hundreds of years ago.

Pirate poetry

In the last week of this term, we will have lots of fun reading pirate poems and have a go at reciting our own pirate poems.

Maths

Fractions

In this unit the children will recognise and name different fractions of an object and a quantity using pictorial representations.

Multiplication and division

The children will learn how to solve problems involving multiplication and division. They will also practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Geometry

We will be looking at position, direction and movement.

Religious Education

In RE, our focus for this term is Judaism. The children will be understanding and exploring the celebration of Shabbat.

Computing

This term the children will be treasure hunters and use their pirate skills to search and find information during our computer lessons.

The children will continue to be practicing their typing skills.

Science

In Science the children will be recapping learning that they have acquired throughout this year. We will deepen our knowledge in the subjects we have covered including the human body, plants and materials.

Physical Education

In P.E this term, the children will practise and learn the basic skills of tennis. They will learn how to use a racket safely and begin to apply these skills to a game situation.

Art and Design

Through this area of learning, the children will create various pirate-themed art, including a final box construction pirate ship.

PSHE

PSHE lessons will focus on relationships in and outside of the classroom. This will include family relationships, friendships and people who help us.

Character


We will be working on the school value of respect in all that we do. An important aspect of our daily classroom environment is based upon the quote, 'Treat others the way you want to be treated'.

Coaching

Throughout this term we will link our coaching to our PSHE lessons. We will look at friendship and how we can be a great friend to everyone in the classroom.

Communities

We will learn about what life was like for pirates and how it differs from our lives today.



Conservation

As Earth day falls in the first week back at school this term, we will be discussing our planet throughout this term. We will be discussing the importance of our planet to us and how we can help look after it.

Curiosity

We will be linking our curriculum driver of curiosity, to the understanding of the different pirate myths and legends that we commonly hear. The children will ask questions, listen and debate which myths and legends could be real.
