



Dear Parents and Carers

As you will know from previous correspondence, we are planning to run a Summer Camp following on from the success of Summer School last year.

This will be a fantastic opportunity for pupils to participate in activities led by Piggott teachers, Pastoral Staff, and support staff, helping the children form positive relationships and get to know the school site and facilities. Students will participate in a tutor group challenge, having taster sessions in a variety of curriculum areas as well as participating in a tutor group sports tournament in the afternoons.

The Camp will run from Tuesday 23rd August – Thursday 25th August inclusive, 9:30am until 2:30pm. The Summer Camp will be open to our new Year 7 intake only. As we will not be receiving government funding this year, we will be asking for a contribution of £50 for the 3 days or £20 per day. Please indicate which days your child will be attending on the online form.

Students should dress practically for sports and outdoor activities and should bring a school lunch. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, please highlight this on the consent form and a packed lunch will be provided by the school. If you are receipt of Pupil Premium your place will be funded by the school – please highlight this on the consent form.

This will be a chance for your child to work alongside the rest of their new year group and meet some of the teachers, their Head of Year and Head of Key Stage ahead of starting school in September.

If you would like your child to take part in the summer school, we will need payment and consent by 7th July 2022. Online payment is preferred via Scopay, details of how to set up Scopay will be provided on Wednesday 22nd June, on the induction day.
