## Year 10 Photography trip – Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September

On Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September we have planned a visit to Brooklands Motor Museum in Weybridge, KT13 OSL.

The aim of the trip is to develop the students' skills of recording and provide them with an opportunity to photograph a wide variety of vehicles, mechanical forms and structures. The museum houses a diverse mix of both modern and historical transport allowing students the opportunity to create photographs which are not accessible in school or locally. The resulting photographs will be the foundations of a much larger project that will be integral to their GCSE Photography coursework.

Students do not have to wear school uniform, but they should dress appropriately for the weather as we will be partly outdoors. They should bring a waterproof coat in case of rain and, if they wish, a face covering and hand sanitiser for personal use. Students will need to bring a drink and a packed lunch – no fizzy drinks or sweets. Students will be divided into groups and will be accompanied by a member of staff whilst visiting the museum.

Students may bring a camera or may use a mobile phone for photographic purposes, but it is the student's responsibility to keep these items safe. Students will need to be able to upload their photographs onto the school system after the trip, so please ensure that they will be able to do so with their choice of camera / phone.

The coach will depart the school at **9.00am**. Students should arrive in school at the normal time for registration to facilitate a prompt departure. The coaches will aim to return to school for **3.30pm**.

The voluntary contribution for the trip will be **£27.** Should the numbers fall below the required figure then there will either be an increase in the cost or, if there is insufficient interest, the trip may not take place. If your son/daughter is in receipt of free school meals or pupil premium, the school may be able to offer a funded place on the trip. If you require financial assistance, please contact me by email to request this.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, we will need consent and payment by **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September**. Consent should be provided online in the SCOpay website or app, as part of the online payment process.
