- 3) Devise a strategy to help learn the word: use a mnemonic (eg **D**ogs **O**ften **E**at **S**ausages – DOES), look at the word shape - is there a recognisable pattern of ascenders and descenders like in the word **elephant**, look at the way the word is built up from prefixes, roots & suffixes (*un* –comfort –*able* or *trans* – port - *ed*)
