



Visit to The Earth Trust, Little Wittenham, Oxfordshire

16 November 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term Year 5 will be learning about the human and physical features of the local area in geography. Arrangements have been made for the Year 5 class to visit The Earth Trust to explore this further, recording the features using field sketch techniques and to take part in a Rivers Day workshop. This will take place on **Tuesday 6th December**. The children will travel by coach to Little Wittenham and return for the normal end of day collection.

The day will be a predominately outside. Therefore it is important to have the items below:

- Warm, old clothes, which can get wet or muddy.
- Gloves and woolly hat in cold weather.
- We recommend long trousers, no matter what the weather, to protect from brambles & nettles.
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them).
- Wellington boots – fantastic for mud or long wet grass.
- Strong shoes, boots or trainers if the weather is dry.
- Snack for the morning and packed lunch.

The voluntary contribution required for the trip to take place, based on 31 pupils, will be £15.00 per pupil. Horseman Coaches have very kindly donated the cost of the coach travel.

The cost includes: Entrance and workshop, Insurance and administration.

Please be aware that if there are insufficient contributions to cover the cost of the visit, there may be no alternative but to cancel the trip. If your son/daughter is in receipt of pupil premium, the school may be able to support with the funding of the trip. Should you require financial assistance, please contact the school office for further details.
