Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our science unit of learning exploring forces and magnets, arrangements have been made for the Year 3 class to visit Silverstone Interactive Museum. This will take place on **Wednesday 19th April**. The children will travel by coach to Silverstone and will return to school at 4.00pm

The voluntary contribution required for the trip to take place, based on 30 pupils, will be £28.50 per pupil.

This cost includes:

- Coach Travel with Horseman Coaches
- Entry to the main Exhibition, access to the Heritage Track Trail and a STEM workshop
- Insurance and administration

Please be aware that if there are insufficient contributions to cover the cost of the visit, there may be no alternative but to cancel the trip. If your son/daughter is in receipt of pupil premium, the school may be able to support with the funding of the trip.
