PE Grant and Sports Funding Statement 2022-2023

In the academic year 2022-2023 the government will provide additional funding to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. For the academic year 2022-2023, The Piggott School: Charvil Primary will receive £17,760.

Brief overview of PE and sport provision in the school:

The vision of PE at The Piggott School: Charvil Primary is to inspire and facilitate a lifetime love of physical education and sport. Every week, we offer two sessions of physical education to every student. Work units are set aside for each half term. The Early Learning Goals are used as a guide for the Foundation Stage teachings, which focus on physical development. Lessons in KS1 and KS2 adhere to the National Curriculum Programs of Study. Years 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Key Stage 2 receive swimming lessons for one term each year.
