Practical arrangements for the dissemination of results

A Level and Level 3 vocational results will be available to students on Thursday 17th August from 9am.

Results can be collected from the Main Hall at this time. Collection will be in person (unless you have made prior arrangements with Mrs Middleton). Examination results will only be released to the named student on the statement of results.

As well as the opportunity to collect your results, we will email your results to your school email account from 10am. Please ensure, in advance of this date, that you can access your emails. Due to data protection, results will be issued to students and will not be emailed to parents/carers.

Advice and guidance available to students

Support, advice, and guidance will be available on the results day should you need it.

The school will be open to offer face to face support for students who require specific guidance for their next destination (college or university). Support will be available from 8:30am – 11am in the 6th form Common room.
